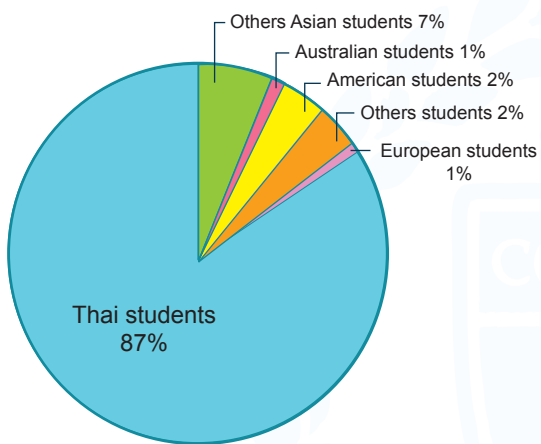

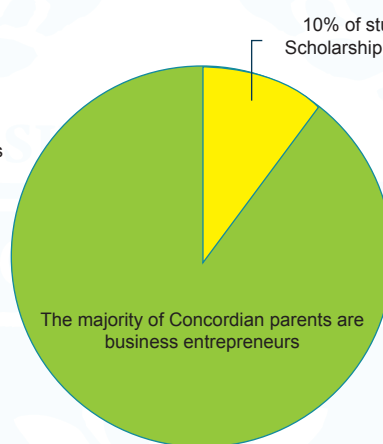
### History of Concordian

Concordian is an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School offering three IB Programs -- the Primary Years Program (PYP), the Middle Years Program (MYP) and the Diploma Program (DP), from K1 to Grade 12. The school was founded in 2001 as a private coeducational college-preparatory school, and has a current total enrollment of 851 students. The first graduating cohort received their Diplomas in 2010.

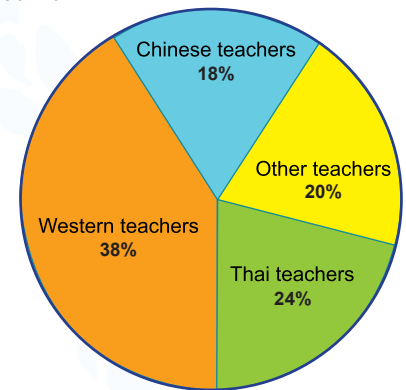
### Concordian Community

### Academic Program

After successful completion of Grade 10 in the MYP, it is an expectation that all students enter the Diploma Program (DP). Thus, making the program **non-selective**. To accommodate the varying abilities of all students, Concordian offers a wide-range of DP subjects within the six subject groups.

### Concordian High School Diploma Requirements (Grades 9-12)

The school year is divided into two semesters. The first semester begins in early August and ends in mid-January and the second semester ends in early June. On the successful completion of each subject over two semesters per year, the students receive 1 credit.

Graduation requirements for a Concordian High School Diploma is a **minimum** of 24 academic credits including Service Learning and Creativity, Action and Service for 4 years.

- complete the Creativity, Action and Service (CAS) component.

**Successful students receive both the Concordian High School Diploma and the IB Diploma.**

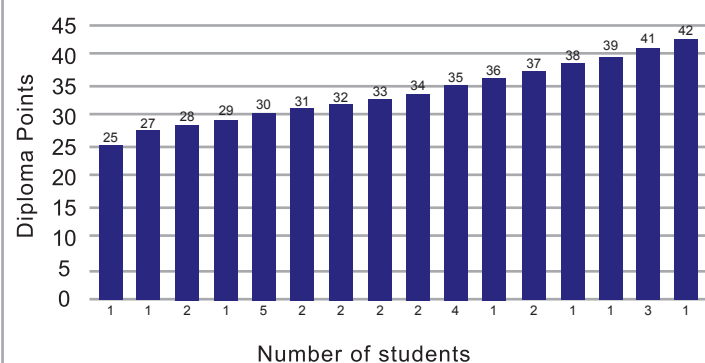

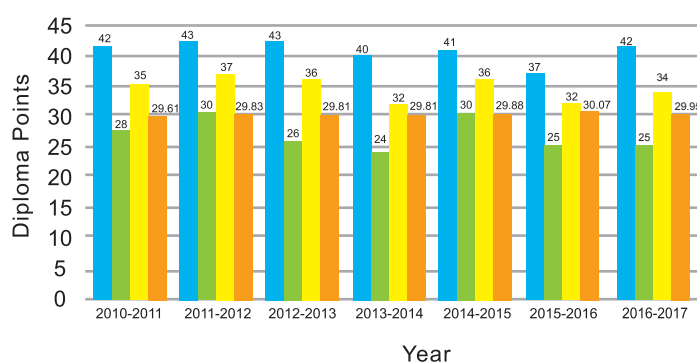
### IB Diploma Result of the Class of 2017

■ IB Diploma Points



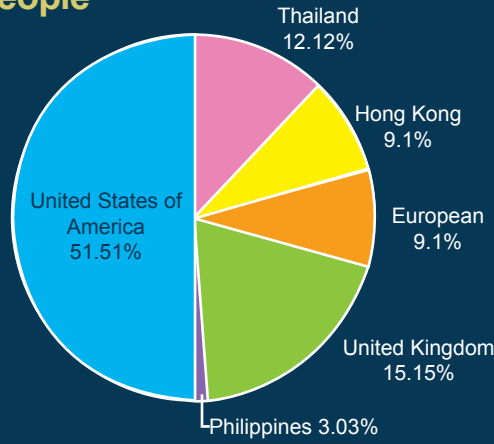
### IB Diploma Point for 2011-2017
