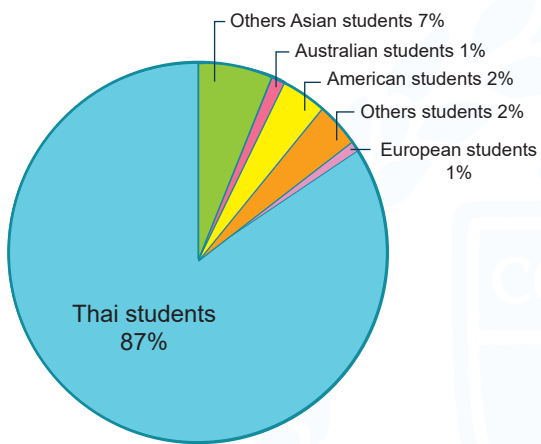

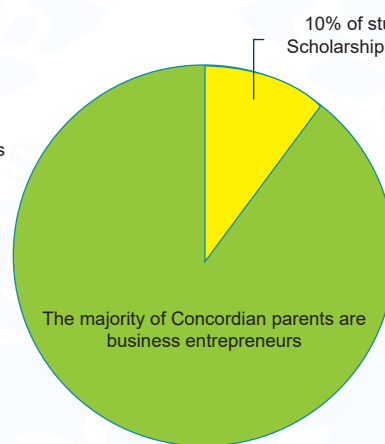
History of Concordian

Concordian is an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School offering three IB Programs -- the Primary Years Program (PYP), the Middle Years Program (MYP) and the Diploma Program (DP), from K1 to Grade 12. The school was founded in 2001 as a private coeducational college-preparatory school, and has a current total enrollment of 851 students. The first graduating cohort received their Diplomas in 2010.

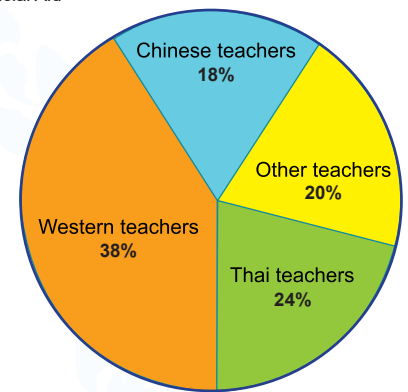

Academic Program

After successful completion of Grade 10 in the MYP, it is an expectation that all students enter the Diploma Program (DP). Thus, making the program **non-selective**. To accommodate the varying abilities of all students, Concordian offers a wide-range of DP subjects within the six subject groups.

Concordian High School Diploma Requirements (Grades 9-12)

The school year is divided into two semesters. The first semester begins in early August and ends in mid-January and the second semester ends in early June. On the successful completion of each subject over two semesters per year, the students receive 1 credit.

Graduation requirements for a Concordian High School Diploma is a **minimum** of 25 academic credits including Service Learning and Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) for 4 years.

In recent years, and particularly this year, our students have had less access to SAT/ SAT subject and ACT tests because of fewer test dates abroad, few sites offering the test, score cancellations, technology difficulties and higher fees. We ask that all higher education institutions take this into account when evaluating our student's applications.

IB Diploma Requirements (Grades 11-12)

Subjects Offered: All subjects are offered at Standard Level (SL) and Higher Level (HL) except where designated. Each student will take a minimum of 3 HL Subjects and 3 SL Subjects.

DP Requirements:

Selection of 6 subjects from Group 1-6 or Groups 1-5 with a Group 6 Subject being optional; 3 subjects at higher level (HL) and 3 subjects of standard level (SL)

Complete the three core elements

- Theory of Knowledge (TOK)
- Research/ Investigative 4,000 words extended essay (EE)
- Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS – 18 months)

Successful students receive both the Concordian High School Diploma and the IB Diploma.

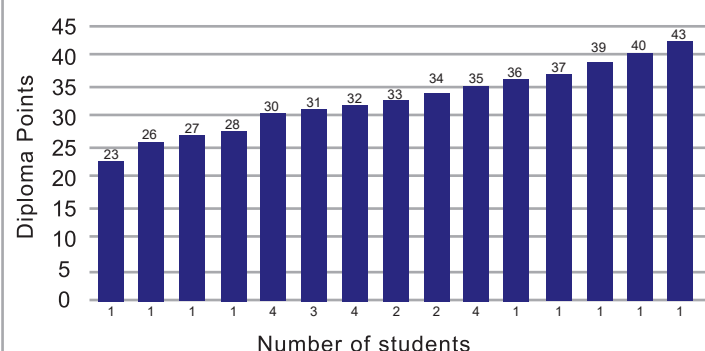
Additional Information: The grading scale is based on a 1 to 7 with 7 being the highest and 1 being the lowest. If students are required to **repeat a course**, it will be indicated on their transcript with the most recent grade showing with an asterisk beside it. In relation to **Disciplinary Infractions**, the school is open to disclose a student's **disciplinary infraction** if any, and if requested by the university to which the student has applied. Concordian consistently strives to maintain integrity and honesty in our collaboration with universities.

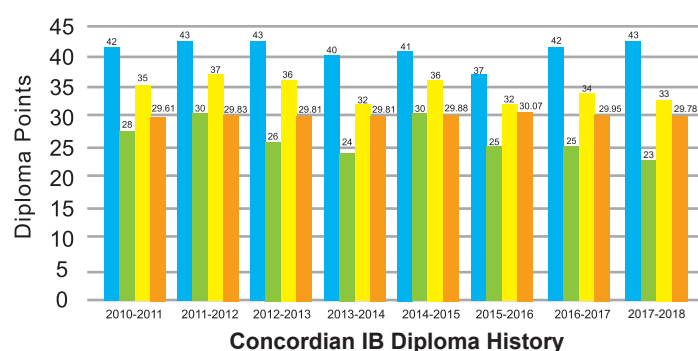
IB Diploma Result of the Class of 2018

■ IB Diploma Points



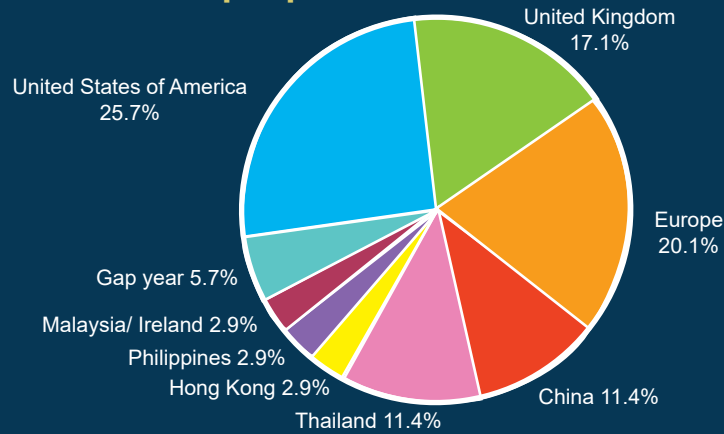
IB Diploma Point for 2011-2018
