**Documents to be submitted with this application**

*(Your application cannot be processed until **ALL** of the following have been received)*

1. Two recommendation letters from the school counselor and a teacher
2. 10 Hallmarks of IB Students: Personal Assessment and 2 short essays (*see notes\**)
3. Submit a CV/Portfolio detailing the community services or extracurricular activities
4. A Student's potential for making positive contributions to Concordian and its Community , please write a plan

*\*Essay no. 1 : Write a minimum of one A4 page essay describing your strongest characteristic, based on one of the ten hallmarks of IB students, using examples to support your statement.*

*\*Essay no. 2 : Write a minimum of one A4 page essay describing an area (you may include ideas outside of the Hallmarks of an IB student) in which you feel you need to improve. Include why you feel that you need to improve in this area and a short plan for improvement.*

**Scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:**

1. Test scores in Math and English.
2. Overall academic success over the last four years
3. Personal Assessment and the short essays
4. Personal Interview

**Notes:**

- Deadline for the applicants **is no later than 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020.**
- Please remember that if the applicant provides inaccurate or misleading information, Concordian International School reserves the right to restrict entry to the school, including the cancellation of any scholarship.
- Concordian has a variety of different tiers of scholarships. Scholarships of 25%, 50% or 100% of the tuition fees are available and are based on the student's performance. In order to be eligible for a full 100% tuition scholarship, the applicant must have achieved an Acer score of more than 95% in both Math and English as well as high performances in other assessments. The costs to be borne by you will be uniforms, lunches, field trips and any other incidentals, including school supplies and textbooks.
- Only successful applicants will be asked to attend an interview and take our internal tests.
